
PORINI LION CAMP





Situated in the Olare Motorogi Conservancy, Porini Lion Camp offers unrivaled big cat sightings including lions, leopards, and cheetahs. With only ten solar-powered tents, this eco-camp provides an exclusive, low-impact safari in one of the most predator-rich areas of the Maasai Mara.



LOCATION AND ACCESS

Olare Motorogi Conservancy is a private 33,000-acre wilderness directly bordering the Maasai Mara. The conservancy was created through partnerships with local Maasai landowners, offering protection to vital wildlife corridors and sustainable tourism revenue to the community.

Porini Lion Camp is the only Porini presence here, providing unrivaled privacy and predator encounters. The conservancy enforces a strict vehicle limit, ensuring guests experience the best of the Mara ecosystem—without the crowds.

Getting There:

- Schedule a flight from Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport or Wilson Airport to the nearby Olare Orok airstrip.
- Travel by road to Olare Motorogi Conservancy (approximate driving duration from Nairobi is 5.5 hours)

Complimentary airstrip / airport transfers to / from Olare Orok to the camp.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Located in the renowned 33,000-acre Olare Motorogi Conservancy, Porini Lion Camp places guests at the center of Kenya's most predator-rich wilderness. This conservancy borders the Maasai Mara and is famed for its thriving lion populations, leopards, cheetahs, and big game.

Porini Lion Camp is **the only Porini property in Olare Motorogi**, giving it exclusive access to some of the most scenic and wildlife-dense areas in the region. No mass tourism. No vehicle congestion. Just raw, untamed nature.

Guests benefit from **extended game drives into the Maasai Mara National Reserve** while enjoying the privacy of a private conservancy that limits visitor numbers. The camp's location also provides **access to key wildlife corridors used during the Great Migration**.

Sustainably designed and solar-powered, the camp delivers high-comfort, low-impact safari living. Porini Lion Camp is **community-focused**, with Maasai staff, local conservation partnerships, and a deep commitment to protecting Kenya's iconic big cats.

CONSERVANCIES

Porini Lion Camp is located in the Olare Motorogi Conservancy, encompassing 33,000 acres of exceptional natural beauty and ecological value, is a vital wildlife area bordering the Maasai Mara National Reserve. Formed by the merging of the former Olare Orok and Motorogi conservancies, it features diverse landscapes including the lower valleys of the Olare Orok and Ntiakitiak rivers, riverine forests, the dramatic Ntiakitiak Gorge, and a 12km escarpment overlooking expansive acacia woodlands. With a rich variety of wildlife, ranging from predators to large herbivores and one of the lowest tourist densities in the Mara, the conservancy offers an exclusive and immersive safari experience. Only a limited number of 4x4 vehicles from a few small camps operate here, ensuring a truly wild and serene environment for guests.

SUSTAINABILITY

Porini Lion Camp is a model of eco-tourism, built and operated to leave a minimal footprint while maximizing conservation impact. If the camp were to be moved, in a few months and with some rains one would not know there was anything there. This gold eco-rated camp runs on solar power, uses environmentally sensitive materials, and avoids permanent infrastructure to preserve the land's natural integrity. Guests have the opportunity to support the Wildlife Habitat Trust (WHT), with 100% of donations going directly to our community. Every guest stay directly supports conservation management, helping to protect biodiversity, restore habitats, and maintain the health of the Olare Motorogi ecosystem. By prioritizing sustainability at every level, Porini sets a standard for responsible tourism in Africa.

COMMUNITY

Porini Camps were established on a foundation of partnership with local Maasai landowners, creating a conservation model that benefits both people and nature. Through long-term land lease payments, employment opportunities, and community development support, Porini helps sustain livelihoods while incentivizing the protection of wildlife habitat.

Guests are welcomed into this relationship and can engage meaningfully through cultural visits to villages or schools—fostering connection, understanding, and mutual respect. This shared approach ensures that conservation success is deeply rooted in community support.

Additionally, guests have the opportunity to support community initiatives through the Wildlife Habitat Trust, which funds projects focused on education, healthcare, and sustainable livelihoods—such as youth beekeeping programs. Every contribution goes entirely to the projects, ensuring direct and meaningful impact.
