



The Gamewatchers Adventure Camping Safaris have been designed to offer the same high quality wildlife safari experience provided by the top-end safari camps. Game drives are in 4x4 vehicles, escorted by top class guides, and in exclusive wildlife conservancies away from the tourist minibuses. The Adventure Camps offer “real camping” instead of the luxury accommodation of the expensive up-market tented lodges, thus making them affordable for the cost conscious, adventure traveler. Transport between Nairobi and the Adventure Camp is by light aircraft to avoid the long, overland drives on rough roads and to have more quality time on safari for various other activities.

LOCATION

The Gamewatchers Adventure Camps are located in private conservancies that offer a large diversity of wildlife. Guided walks and night game drives are available. The Camps are also located for convenient access to the Amboseli National Park and the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. The Gamewatchers Adventure Safari Camps are set up on our own exclusive camp sites in the Selenkay Conservancy in the Amboseli eco-system and in the Ol Kinyei Conservancy in the Mara eco-system.



THE CAMP

For those who feel that the safari experience is more important than the accommodation, the camp provides the ideal, basic set up with dome tents – 2 man tents that can also fit one child with 2 adults. Bring your own sleeping bag, or one can be provided, and your bed is a thick and comfortable mattress on the floor. Experience exclusive wildlife viewing with high quality guiding at a fraction of the price. Each tent has its own private bathroom in a cubicle located behind the tent with flush toilet, wash basin and safari shower.



THE EXPERIENCE

All game drives are in four-wheel drive customized safari vehicles taking a maximum of 6 passengers. Your driver-guide is a wildlife expert and certified by the Kenya Professional Safari Guides Association.

At each safari campsite, you will be welcomed by your safari guide. Service staff will wash up, clean, heat water for showers, cook and serve the food. An experienced safari chef is at the camp to freshly bake the bread and prepare all the meals.

Food is delicious and of the same quality as any luxury safari camp and is included in the price. Mineral water is provided daily at camp and on game drives and walks. Other drinks are not included, however, beer, house wine and soft drinks can be purchased at the camps, and there is no corkage fee for bringing a bottle of your favourite spirit.

DAY PROGRAMME

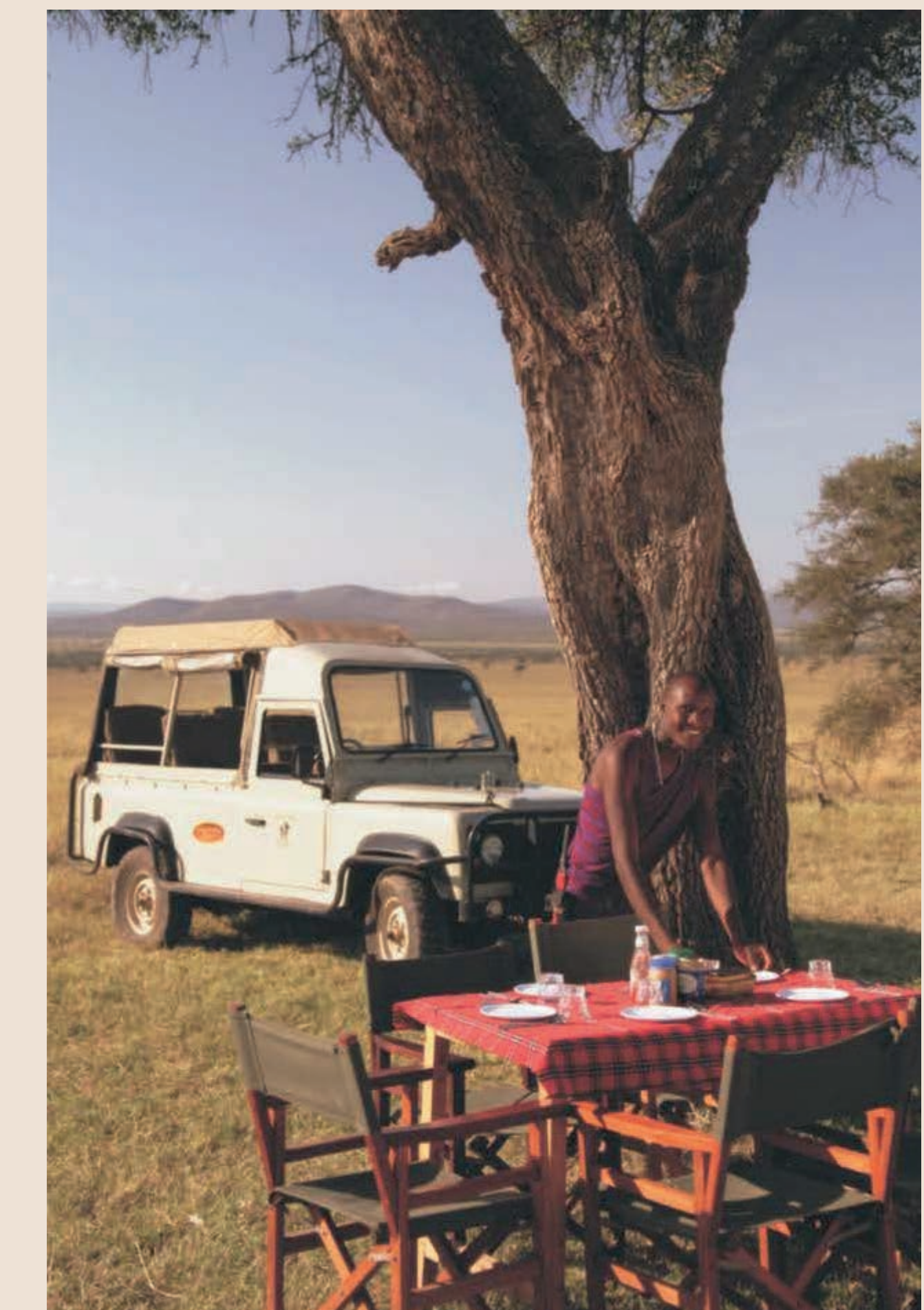
The camping safari departs daily from Nairobi from the 20th December until the 31st March and from 1st July to the 31st October.

Guests can choose from a 3 night / 4 day Safari to Ol Kinyei Adventure Camp including return flights from Nairobi to Mara and all game drives in 4x4 vehicles from the camp OR A 3 night / 4 day Safari to Selenkay Adventure Camp including return flight from Nairobi to Selenkay and all game drives in 4x4 vehicles from the camp OR 6 night/ 7 day Safari visiting both Amboseli & Mara including flights from Nairobi to Selenkay return and Nairobi - Mara return with all game drives in 4x4 vehicles from the camp.

CONSERVATION

The Maasai community in Selenkay and Ol Kinyei are receiving direct benefits from Wildlife and now see Wildlife as a valuable resource which belongs to them. They earn direct income from each guest in the conservancy and over 95% of the staff in the Adventure Camps come directly from the community. As a result of this, there has been a significant improvement in big cat numbers in both conservancies, and in Selenkay, elephants have returned after an absence of over 20 years. Guests staying at the Adventure Camps are making a direct contribution to conservation and supporting local communities.



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
